As we entered the negotiations for our house here in Bedworth, we were told that we would need to provide \$11,000.00 AUD to rent it for 6 months. This was for us, impossible. Scott sent an email out requesting prayer and or help with finances. But God was already at work.

We received an email from our missions contact for a church in Texas, telling us the following story.

On Friday night God had woken a lady, from the church in Texas that supports us, and told her to

pray for a man called Thomson, she was unsure who this person was specifically but began to pray and felt a real sense of urgency. As a result of much prayer she felt God say that, “the full provision was on it’s way”. It was only on the following Sunday morning that she heard about our need and knew that we were the ones she had been led to pray for.

We’d had to use all of our car money to secure the house, but we were given a car before we even arrived in the UK. We have yet to see the “full” provision but we know that God is faithful to His word.

As a result we have a real sense of security and courage that God is for us.

God is so good.

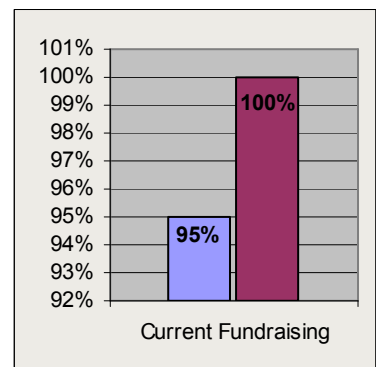
Having said that we have managed to rent a home

From there we made our way the 2 hours to Bedworth, picked up the keys to the home we are renting and immediately set to cleaning, needless to say it was a very long and tiring 2 days.

Everyone connected with NLI has been fantastic and very supportive during the last couple of weeks of transition. Many of you have contacted us and helped to dissipate the isolation we sometimes feel, thank you for your care and concern.

The weather has been interesting; we had
